## Gifted Program

Eligibility for the gifted program will be based on achievement of the following:

## Fourth through Sixth Grades - Elementary Program

## Academic Achievement

- Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment (Reading and Math)
$>$ Nine most recent test sessions - Reading and Math (considering Fall, Winter, \& Spring)
All sessions points averaged to give overall academic score (0 to 5)
On each test:
- 97 Percentile -5 points
- 95 " Percentile -3 points
- $90^{\text { }}$ Percentile -1 point
- Lower than $90^{*}$ Percentile - zero points


## Classroom Performance

- Renzulli Rating Scales - Learning, Motivation, Creativity, Reading, \& Math
$>$ Each Scale has questions on a 6 point scale.
Three most recent sessions points averaged to give overall academic score (0 to 5)

On each test:

- Average 5.5 to $6-5$ points
- Average 5.0 to $5.5-3$ points
- Average 4.5 to $5.0-1$ point
- Less than 4.5 average - zero points

Entrance is calculated by adding Academic Achievement and Classroom Performance Scores (10 points total possible).

6 points needed for entrance into gifted program.
Scores of 5.9 to 6 will be recommended for consideration:
independent assessment in non-verbal performance by District psychologists team using the Stanford-Binet 5

- $95^{\text {r }}$ Percentile -3 points
- $90^{\text {t }}$ Percentile -1 point
- Lower than $90^{\text {i }}$ Percentile - zero points
