INSTRUCTION

Gifted Program

Eligibility for the gifted program will be based on achievement of the following:

Fourth through Sixth Grades – Elementary Program

Academic Achievement

- Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment (Reading and Math)
 - Nine most recent test sessions Reading and Math (considering Fall, Winter, & Spring)

All sessions points averaged to give overall academic score (0 to 5)

On each test:

- o 97th Percentile − 5 points
- o 95th Percentile − 3 points
- o 90th Percentile − 1 point
- o Lower than 90th Percentile zero points

Classroom Performance

- Renzulli Rating Scales Learning, Motivation, Creativity, Reading, & Math
 - ➤ Each Scale has questions on a 6 point scale. Three most recent sessions points averaged to give overall academic score (0 to 5)

On each test:

- \circ Average 5.5 to 6 5 points
- o Average 5.0 to 5.5 3 points
- Average 4.5 to 5.0 1 point
- Less than 4.5 average zero points

Entrance is calculated by adding Academic Achievement and Classroom Performance Scores (10 points total possible).

6 points needed for entrance into gifted program.

Scores of 5.9 to 6 will be recommended for consideration:

independent assessment in non-verbal performance by District psychologists team using the Stanford-Binet 5

Academic Achievement

- Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment (Reading)

 - ➤ Each Scale has questions on a 6 point scale.

 Three most recent sessions points averaged to give overall academic score (0 to 5)

On each test:

- Average 5.5 to 6 5 points
- \circ Average 5.0 to 5.5 3 points
- Average 4.5 to 5.0 1 point
- o Less than 4.5 average zero points

Entrance is calculated by adding Academic Achievement and Classroom Performance Scores (10 points total possible).

6 points needed for entrance into gifted program.

Scores of 5.9 to 6 will be recommended for consideration:
