Community comes together to develop roadmap for future

The District 58 Strategic Plan was developed in partnership with the community during the 2010–11 school year, and approved by the Board of Education in July 2011. The level of stakeholder involvement in the process, led by a steering committee of administrators, board members, staff and parents, was gratifying. More than 1,400 community members responded to our survey in fall 2010, and nearly 100 stakeholders participated in our community engagement workshop in March 2011. The feedback offered via the survey and the workshop reflected a high level of support for District 58's current programs and services.

The Strategic Plan was created as a touchstone, reflecting the priorities of our community and providing a set of guidelines and parameters to guide future

decision-making within District 58. It is expected that District 58, including administration, staff, board members, and the community we serve, will refer to this Strategic Plan when setting goals, creating plans for school improvement, developing programming for students, and allocating funding. - 2) STUDENT WELL-BEING/
 SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING District 58 will teach
 Social-Emotional Learning
 skills in a safe, comfortable,
 child-focused environment.
 The ultimate goal is to develop
 self-disciplined, self-knowing,
 empathetic students who have
 the strong interpersonal and
 communication skills needed
 to be contributing members
 of a global society.
- TEACHING AND LEARNING
 Technology in District 58
 will enhance and transform
 learning and instruction
 by providing students with
 creative, collaborative, and
 meaningful learning experiences; guiding students in
 making powerful connections;
 providing students with
 opportunities to develop
 collaborative skills; and serving
 as a springboard for lifelong
 learning and connectedness.

 OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE District 58 will ensure
 that its schools and other
