Dear Fairmount Staff and Families:

District 58 was notified that two Fairmount sixth grade students tested positive for COVID-19 on Wednesday, Jan. 13. Both students have not been at school since Monday, Jan. 11. We do not believe these cases are connected to each other because the two students attend different sessions (one is in the a.m. session; the other is in the p.m. session).

Per Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) guidelines, the students must stay home at least 10 calendar days from onset of symptoms or, for asymptomatic cases, from the COVID-19 test date, AND for 24 hours with no fever (without fever-reducing medication) AND improvement of symptoms. The students are following these requirements.

At this time, we do not believe the students were in close contact with any District 58 students or staff members while at school due to the students maintaining strict social distancing requirements. However, one of the students is a bus rider. The District is working with the bus company to determine if there were any close contacts while the student was on the bus. If a close contact is confirmed, the District will promptly notify the families of affected students. We hope to confirm close contacts within the next day. If you do not hear from your school principal or assistant principal by tomorrow, please assume your child is not a close contact.

In the event the District learns there were close contacts with students or staff inside or outside of school, those individuals will be required to complete a 10-to-14 day quarantine. Quarantine length is situation-specific; please see footnote 7 on [this IDPH exclusion guidance sheet](#) for detailed close contact quarantine requirements. There is no known school link to this case.

District 58 will continue to follow all protocols outlined by the IDPH when a student or staff member tests positive. Additionally, the District's custodial staff thoroughly cleans and disinfects all areas of our schools and offices every evening. Elementary schools are also disinfected between morning and afternoon sessions.

District 58 also notified the DuPage County Health Department of these positive cases to ensure that protocols, contact tracing and the self-certification process were strictly followed. The health and safety of our students, staff and families is paramount, and we will continue to follow all guidelines called for by the IDPH and the DCHD. Please continue to wear masks, adhere to social distancing requirements, and thoroughly wash and/or sanitize your hands as this is the best way to combat the spread of COVID-19.
