Year-to-Date

The Year-to-Date Report shows that the District's revenues and expenses are following expected trends when compared with last year.

Bond Sale Review

The first issue of \$124 million in referendum bonds was completed in November. A second issuance will occur in two to three years. The District will invest the bond proceeds with one of the following companies: IIIT, Fifth Third Securities, or PMA.

FY 2022 Audit

The audit will be presented to the Board at the December 12th meeting. There were no significant findings by the auditors.

Review of Summer 2023 Capital Work: Playgrounds

\$1.4 million in a state grant to update playgrounds. The funds are earmarked for particular schools and funds cannot be reallocated. Eight playgrounds will be under construction in summer 2023. Other summer projects include the completion of the fire alarm and masonry work from 2022, and asbestos abatement at Henry Puffer, which is funded in part by the School Maintenance Project Grant.

Next Steps in Capital Planning

A construction plan is in progress by Wight & Co. (architect) and Bulley & Andrews (construction manager). Visioning sessions are planning to include all stakeholders in the final design.
